Scholars who accept membership and are inducted into the chapter should be aware of the time and commitment involved with this honor. We will hold monthly chapter meetings as scheduled and announced from 7:15am to 7:55am. All members must be present for monthly meetings.

Members are required to purchase a Willie Brown Honor Society NEHS shirt. Financial aide will be available to members upon request.

Members must also participate in chapter service projects to benefit the school and community. The Willie Brown Honor Society will perform at least one service project in the 2019-2020 school year. It is the member's obligation to participate in and support all chapter projects throughout the year, whether these involve service, fundraising, leadership and training, or other outreach to the school or community. It is expected that members will also promote service by supporting service activities done by other groups both at school and in the community.

Finally, all scholars must meet and maintain the minimum qualifications for membership, which is based on the four pillars of NEHS:

- **Scholarship**

At a minimum, scholars must have a cumulative grade average of 96%.

- **Responsibility**

Scholars must maintain an Excellent conduct grade in Homeroom and Satisfactory conduct grade in PE, Computer/Technology, Art, and Music.

- **Service**

This involves voluntary contributions made by a scholar to the school or community, done without compensation.

- **Leadership**

Scholar leaders are those who are resourceful, good problem solvers, and idea contributors. Leadership experiences can be drawn from school or community activities while working with or for others.
